DESCRIPTION: These temporary positions have been created in response to the COVID-19 pandemic in order to assist with the administration of vaccines. This position provides support and assistance to those administering COVID-19 vaccines. The work involves responsibility for administering emergency medical care and basic life support to persons who have suffered illness or injury and other medical care in accordance with their scope of practice, relevant state laws and regulations. The incumbents will work under the direction of the Director of Emergency Services, Public Health Director, Director of Public Health Planning and Emergency Preparedness, County EMS Systems Coordinator, NCDOH Medical Consultant, or other designated supervisor. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: <u>Graduation from high school or possession of an</u> <u>equivalency diploma and possession of the following requirements at the time of</u> <u>application, appointment and during the service in this classification:</u>

1. Emergency Medical Technician certification issued by the New York State Department of Health;

2. Possession of a valid NYS driver's license;

3. Completion of regional and agency credentialing requirements;

4. Completion of NYSDOH Bureau of EMS COVID Vaccine administration training (prior to or once hired);

5. Current CPR Card.
