DESCRIPTION: Responsibilities include maintaining a caseload of individuals, assessing them for appropriate admission to integrated care services and providing medically necessary treatment to reduce or eliminate the symptoms related to the presenting problem. The work is performed under the general supervision of a higher-level mental health administrator with leeway permitted for the exercise of independent judgment in carrying out the details of the work. Does related work as required. Followup on medical orders of doctor. Provide therapy and medical aftercare to Mental Health clients. Watch for symptoms and side effects from medications. Medication education, verbal therapy, medication interventions under the supervision of the psychiatrist and coordination of additional services outside the Mental Health Program to meet the requirements of New York State Office of Mental Health.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a current New York State Registered Nurse License. 1 year of paid experience in a supervised mental hygiene program such as mental health, developmental disabilities, alcohol or substance abuse related services, aging services working with Alzheimer's and dementia, or hospice type services working with depression and grief.
