DESCRIPTION: Surveillance, monitoring and follow-up in the communicable disease program, including daily communication with county hospitals, physicians, Niagara County residents and NYSDOH on reportable diseases. Participates in NYSDOH required exercises and drills to prepare for highly contagious or infectious diseases that could cause large numbers of illness or mortality. Daily directly observed therapy home visits to Tuberculosis Control Program patients to observe them taking their medications. The person in this position will also work in STD, TB and immunization clinics and monitor, educate and follow-up with parents and physicians of lead poisoned children. They can also test children for lead poisoning and monitor lead levels and testing history on children attending WIC, Head Start and ABCD Day Care Center. Make home visits to lead poisoned children and those with lead levels of concern. Provide education on STDs in Niagara County high schools. Instruct residents at Chronic Disease Self-Management, Diabetes Self-Management and Diabetes Prevention Program Workshops throughout the county.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Bachelor's degree in nursing.
