The Case Supervisor Grade B provides professional social services work involving responsibility for supervising the activities of Caseworkers administering social service in specified areas or programs in accordance with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations, and agency standards, policies, and procedures. The incumbent may recommend social services policies and procedures and depending on agency needs, they may coordinate the work of various units of the social service program. Under supervision of the Director of Social Services and the Commissioner of Social Services the incumbent supervises a group of caseworkers who render services in a social services program. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: **PROMOTIONAL: One (1) year of permanent competitive status as a Senior Caseworker or two (2) years as a Caseworker in the Niagara County Department of Social Services immediately preceding the date of exam.**

OPEN COMPETITIVE: Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Bachelor's Degree and three (3) years of full time satisfactory paid experience in social work with a public or private social agency adhering to acceptable standards.
