Employees in this position provide service through the 24-hour county-wide Crisis Services Call Center providing needs assessment and referrals on the telephone for a wide range of callers by utilization of the Crisis Intervention Model and suicide assessment procedures. Callers may include, but not be limited to, persons with situational, personal, family disturbances, drug or alcohol problems, etc. Position performs other related duties as needed. Full-time employees will have an established schedule, but with adequate notice, may be required to work alternate shifts for coverage purposes. Part-time positions are 14 hrs/week, Saturday and Sunday, various shifts available.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: <u>Graduation from high school or possession of an</u> <u>equivalency diploma AND one of the following: 1. Graduation from a regionally</u> <u>accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of</u> <u>Regents to grant degrees with an Associate's Degree in a Human Services or Social</u> <u>Sciences field; OR 2.
