This position is responsible for the day-to-day supervision of shift operations of the Niagara County Emergency Medical Services for one or more assigned shifts. The incumbent will be a working supervisor who supervises shift staff and participates in advanced life support services work. The incumbent will also coordinate the provision of emergency medical services within Niagara County with other emergency medical services agencies and providers for specific shifts. The work is performed under the supervision of the Supervising Advanced Life Support Technician in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations, policies, procedures and laws. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: <u>Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and six (6) months of full-time paid experience performing EMT-Paramedic duties.</u>

## <u>SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS AT TIME OF APPLICATION AND FOR DURATION OF EMPLOYMENT:</u>

- 1. Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic certification issued by the New York State Department of Health;
- 2. Possession of a valid NYS driver's license;
