The work involves specific program responsibility and supervision along with assisting a higher level sanitarian or engineer by performing activities of more than ordinary difficulty and responsibility. The work is usually performed under the general direction of a Public Health Engineer or the Associate Supervisory Public Health Sanitarian. Supervision may be exercised over a staff which may include Public Health Sanitarians and Public Health Technicians. Does related work as required.**

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: PROMOTIONAL:

Two (2) years of permanent competitive class status as a Public Health Sanitarian in the Niagara County Health Department immediately preceding the examination.

**Bachelor's Degree including a minimum of thirty (30) credit hours in natural science, of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences; AND EITHER:**

**1. Two (2) years of satisfactory full-time paid experience in public environmental health activities as a Public Health Sanitarian in a New York State city or county or in the State Department of Health; OR**

**2. Two (2) years of equivalent satisfactory full-time paid experience in public environmental health activities.**

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

**Individuals meeting the above requirements may apply for a certificate as a Supervisory Public Health Sanitarian issued by the Niagara County Public Health Director.**

**Possession of the certificate is required at the time of the appointment.**

**Possession of a New York State driver's license at time of appointment and throughout duration of employment.**

**NOTE: Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Doctorate or Master's Degree in public health acceptable to the Niagara County Public Health Director may be substituted for one (1) year of the general experience requirement.**
