The Assistant Public Defender shall counsel and represent the defendant at every stage of the proceedings following his/her arrest and shall initiate such proceedings as in his/her judgment are necessary to protect the rights of the accused and may in his/her discretion prosecute any appeals if in his/her judgment the facts and circumstances warrant such. The work is performed under guidelines provided by law. Represents when directed indigent defendants charged with crimes. Does related work as required under the supervision of the Public Defender.
