As a member or the chief of a survey crew, the incumbent is expected to be able to perform all work related to the survey of roads, bridges, buildings and right-of-way. Work is performed under the supervision of the Deputy Commissioner of Public Works - Engineering, a Senior Civil Engineer, or assigned supervisor. The incumbent may supervise a survey party or the preparation of drawings. Does related work as required.
