These duties require the performance of mental health/behavioral health counseling in helping patients with social, emotional and related difficulties associated with their identified concerns or disability. The work is performed within prescribed routines with some leeway permitted in determining the scope of work to be performed in helping the patient to adjust into his/her old or new environment. Employees in this class are expected to meet with professionals of agencies in or outside of the community to obtain assistance and guidance for patients. The Licensed Clinician functions under the direction of a higher-level assigned supervisor who may define or limit the work to be performed. Does related work as required.

Graduation with a Master's Degree in Social Work, Mental Health Counselor, Marriage and Family Therapist, Creative Arts Therapist, or Psychoanalyst and eligibility for a limited permit.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AT TIME OF APPOINTMENT:**

1. Possession of one of the following: Current New York State license, provisional license, or limited permit as a Master of Social Work, Mental Health Counselor, Marriage and Family Therapist, Creative Arts Therapist, or Psychoanalyst; OR
2. Possession of a current New York State Registered Professional Nurse license and two (2) years of supervised nursing experience in a mental health, behavioral health, or related disability program.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Employees must maintain an appropriate provisional license, limited permit, or permanent license throughout the duration of employment.

1. Degrees must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education.
