An employee in this class will assume a variety of duties including data collection and analysis as well as preparing and presenting public health information for diverse audiences. The work is performed under the general direction of the division director with wide leeway permitted for the exercise of independent judgment in accordance with rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and laws. The incumbent does not exercise any supervision over others. Does related work as required.

OPEN-COMPETITIVE:

2. **Graduation with a Bachelor's degree or higher AND one (1) year of full-time paid professional-level work experience in data collection and analysis and/or public health education.**
